N.B. According to the existing Constitution and Rules:

- (1) No person shall be elected member of the Standing Committee unless he has been a member of Convocation for not less than two years (Convocation Constitution Paragraph 26).
- (2) A retiring member of the Standing Committee is eligible for re-election (Convocation Constitution Paragraph 28).
- (3) An eligible candidate must be nominated in writing by at least ten members entitled to vote and all nominations shall be accompanied by a statement by the candidate that he/she is willing to stand (Convocation Rules Paragraph 40)
- (4) The list of all candidates who have been duly nominated and the first ten valid nominators of each candidate will be included in the Notice of the Ordinary General Meeting at which the election will take place (Convocation Rules Paragraph 41).
